By State Reorganisation Act 1956 & Seventh CAA 1956 14 States & 6 UTs were created



1953 — Andhra State : 1ST Linguistic State
Due to death of Potti Sriramulu



Linguistic Criteria Accepted on Certain Conditions

- a. Unity & Security
- b. Linguistic & Cultural Homogeneity
- c. Financial, Economic & Administrative Considerations
- d. Welfare of People

States & UTs created after 1956

- Gujarat (15th)
- 1960 : Bifurcation of Bombay
- Maharashtra
- Dadra & Nagar Haveli Acquired in 1954. It was administered by locals till 1961, Became part of India (10th CAA, 1961)
- Goa & Daman & Diu acquired in 1960 & became part of India(12th CAA1, 962)
- Puducherry Acquire in 1954 & became part of India (14th CAA,)
- 1963 : Nagaland (16th) created from Assam
- 1966 : Haryana (17th) & Chandigarh (UT) created from Punjab

- 1971 : Himachal Pradesh receive status from UT into State and became 18th
- 1972 : Manipur (19th), Tripura (20th) & Meghalaya (21st) and Mizoram & Arunachal Pradesh were formed as UT.
- 1975 : Sikkim (22nd) became part of India
- 1987 : Mizoram (23rd), Arunachal Pradesh(24th) & Goa (25th) became state.
- 2000 : Chhattisgarh (26th), Uttarakhand (27th) & Jharkhand (28th) were created
- 2014 : Telangana (29th) separated from Andhra Pradesh
- 2019 Two UTs created From Jammu & Kashmir
- Jammu & Kashmir
- Ladakh
- Presently we have 28 states & 8 UTs
